What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to China

Day 2: Beijing

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Beijing, the capital of the People's Republic of China. During your stay, behold the opulence of its ancient temples, palaces, and gates.

Day 3: Beijing

- Take an expertly guided tour of Beijing, where you'll visit Tiananmen Square, the Summer Palace and the Forbidden City, whose grandeur is epitomized by the golden-roofed Imperial Palace.
- Take a dragon boat ride (*April-Oct*).
- Participate in a tai chi lesson.
- Visit a local school (*if in session*).
- Enjoy an authentic Peking duck dinner.

Day 4: Beijing

- Visit a section of the Great Wall of China that's less traveled by tourists and one of its best preserved. Construction of the wall began in the third century B.C.
- Take a cable car ride for a scenic view of the Great Wall.
- See the Bird's Nest Olympic stadium.
- Take a guided walking tour of a Hutong neighborhood. These narrow, interconnected alleysways and courtyard homes date back to the 13th century.
- Enjoy an authentic Chinese meal with Hutong families.

Day 5: Beijing | Xi'an

- Fly to Xi'an, where the massive wall surrounding the city is a testament to its importance: It has served as the capital of 11 dynasties. While here, you'll follow in the footsteps of Silk Road traveler Marco Polo.
- Take a bike ride on the ancient City Wall.
- Enjoy a free evening to explore more Xi'an or [+ take a dumpling class](#).

Day 6: Xi'an

- Take an expertly guided tour of Xi'an.
- Visit the Terracotta Warriors. These life-size sculptures were created to protect the tomb of Emperor Qin Shi Huangdi, founder of the Qin Dynasty. Of these 6,000 models, no two are alike.
- Participate in a calligraphy class.
- Visit a street food market in the city's Muslim quarter.

Day 7: Xi'an | Chengdu

- Travel by high-speed train to Chengdu.
- Tour Chengdu's most famous pedestrian street.
- Take a guided tour of Chengdu. Learn about the city's ancient history with an expert local guide, and see why it's a modern-day hub of communication, economic, and transportation.
- Enjoy a family-style hot pot dinner.
- Explore on your own or [+ enjoy a Sichuan Opera "face-changing" performance](#).

Day 8: Chengdu

- Spend a half day at a panda research center. Learn about the center's research and conservation efforts to save giant pandas.
- Try your hand at picking tea leaves alongside local farmers, and learn about the significance of tea in Chinese culture and daily life.

Day 9: Chengdu | Dujiangyan

- Take in the Chinese countryside on a day trip to a UNESCO World Heritage Site.
- Explore the Dujiangyan Irrigation System, a feat of engineering dating back to 256 B.C.
- Enjoy a cable car ride and short hike to the top of Mount Qingcheng.

Day 10: Chengdu | Shanghai

- Fly to Shanghai and discover a nexus point of ancient custom and modern technology.
- Ascend Shanghai Tower, the tallest building in all of Shanghai and take in this world-class city from the observation deck.
- Enjoy time to explore the Bund at your own pace. Once considered the "Wall Street of the East," the Bund is a waterfront promenade offering a postcard-perfect view of Shanghai's famous skyline.
- Explore more of Shanghai on your own or [+ attend a Chinese acrobatics show](#).

Day 11: Shanghai

- Take an expertly guided tour of Shanghai.
- Visit the Jade Buddha Temple. Sculpted out of white jade, these Buddhas were brought from Burma by a Chinese monk in the last century. One portrays Buddha experiencing Enlightenment, the other his transcendence into Nirvana.
- Stroll past goldfish ponds and admire the classical Chinese landscape in the Yu Garden.
- See Nanjing Lu, or Nanjing Road.

Day 12: Depart for home
