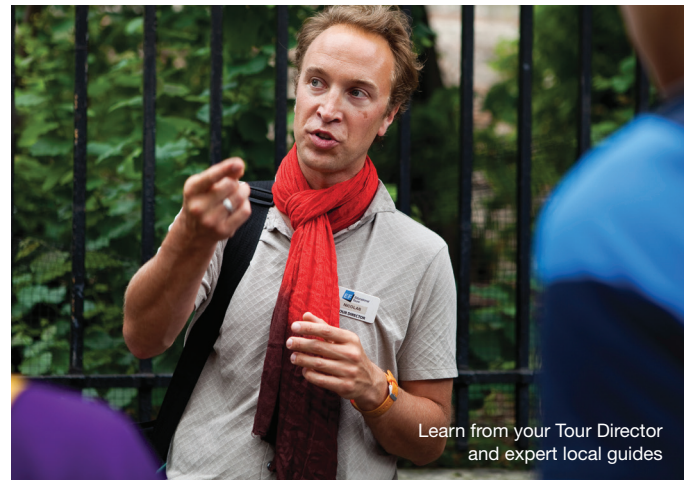

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to the Netherlands

Day 2: Amsterdam

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Amsterdam, a city where 1,200 bridges crisscross 160 canals to make it one of Europe's most charming capitals.
- Explore the city during a Food Market Challenge, tasting your way through a local market in small groups.

Day 3: Amsterdam

- Take an audio-guided boat tour along Amsterdam's iconic canals.
- Visit the Anne Frank House.
- Time to see more of Amsterdam or [visit Volendam and Zaanse Schans](#).

Day 4: Brussels

- Travel to Brussels.
- Take a tour of Brussels: European Union buildings; Grand'Place; Atomium.
- Participate in a Belgian food experience.

Day 5: Paris

- Travel to Paris, the City of Light. During your stay you'll get a taste of Parisian style as you ride down the Champs-Élysées, an elegant boulevard packed with high-fashion boutiques. Pass the Place de la Concorde and the Arc de Triomphe and strike a pose in front of the Eiffel Tower. At the École Militaire, see where a promising young Napoleon launched his rise to power. I.M. Pei's iconic glass pyramid marks the entrance to the renowned Louvre, home to treasures like Leonardo da Vinci's *Mona Lisa*.
- Visit the Louvre.
- Take a walking tour of Paris: Latin Quarter.
- Catch a glimpse of Notre-Dame Cathedral.

Day 6: Paris

- Take an expertly guided tour of Paris: Place de la Concorde; Champs-Élysées; Arc de Triomphe; Les Invalides; Eiffel Tower.
- Time to see more of Paris or [visit Versailles](#).

Day 7: Paris | London

- Travel by Eurostar train to London, a city of eight million people that has become one of the world's great melting pots while maintaining a distinct character that's all its own. From the London Bridge to the Houses of Parliament, Great Britain's royal tradition and rich history greet you at every turn. Admire architectural marvels like the Baroque domes and spires of St. Paul's Cathedral, the 17th-century church designed by Sir Christopher Wren. Check out the lively five-way intersection at Piccadilly Circus as well as Hyde Park's urban greenery. You may even get a chance to witness the ceremonial Changing of the Guard. And don't forget to snap a picture of Big Ben from the banks of the River Thames.
- Ride the London Eye.

Day 8: London

- Take an expertly guided tour of London: Big Ben and Houses of Parliament; Piccadilly Circus; St. Paul's Cathedral; Westminster Abbey.
- Time to see more of London or [visit Windsor Castle](#).

Day 9: Depart for home

- Take a guided excursion to Stonehenge and Bath: Stonehenge stone circles; Georgian squares of Bath.

Day 10: London

- Take a walking tour of London: The Strand; Trafalgar Square; Leicester Square; Covent Garden.
