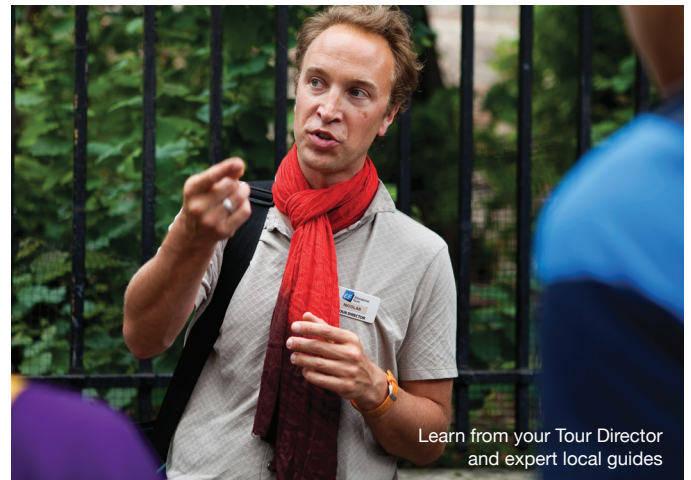

What you'll experience on your tour

Day 1: Fly overnight to the Netherlands

Day 2: Amsterdam

- Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Amsterdam, a city where 1,200 bridges crisscross 160 canals to make it one of Europe's most charming capitals.
- Explore the city during a Food Market Challenge, tasting your way through a local market in small groups.

Day 3: Amsterdam

- Take an audio-guided boat tour along Amsterdam's iconic canals.
- Visit the Anne Frank House, where the young girl hid with her family from 1942 to 1944. This is also the site where she penned her poignant diary, which has been translated into dozens of languages worldwide.

Day 4: Heidelberg

- Take a tour of Heidelberg.
- Visit the Heidelberg Castle wine barrel.

Day 5: Munich

- Take an expertly guided tour of Munich: Olympic Stadium; Residenz; Marienplatz.

Days 6-7: Venice

- Travel via Innsbruck to Venice, the Floating City crisscrossed with romantic bridges, laced with history, and boasting some of the world's finest art and architecture.
- Take an expertly guided tour of Venice: St. Mark's Square; Grand Canal.
- Travel by water taxi to the island of Burano, known for its brightly colored homes and lace work.
