## Value Proposition

The Uterine ElevatOR PRO™ and Uterine ElevatOR PRO with OccludOR Balloon™ are easy-to-use uterine manipulators. The Uterine ElevatOR PRO with OccludOR Balloon™ maintains pneumoperitoneum and exposes the patient's pelvic anatomy for better detention and optimal access to surgical landmarks during laparoscopic and robotic hysterectomies. The Uterine ElevatOR PRO™ and Uterine ElevatOR PRO with OccludOR Balloon™ are available in four cervical cup sizes to accommodate varied anatomy.

- ▶ Firm patient fit into the fornices and available in a range of sizes from small to XLarge for varied uterine anatomy (32, 35, 37, and 40mm). Can be used with electrosurgical and harmonic energy sources.
- ▶ Rounded proximal edge to reduce / eliminate trauma to the vaginal vault upon removal.
- ▶ Easily adjustable seal screw cannot be overtightened and is engineered to be impossible to strip
- ▶ Priced at less than \$80 each (which includes the occluding balloon\*), the Uterine ElevatOR Pro is one of the most competitive on the market when compared to market leaders such as VCare (ConMed) and RUMI (Cooper Surgical)
