If only a small fraction of a customer's environment is using Gliffy, is there any way for them to only pay for those users and not the entire user environment?

We will review any customer case when they feel like only a small percentage of their environment is using Gliffy. We realize there might be cases of limited usage, so we're always open to discussion with the customer or the partner to work out a deal that everyone is happy with.

If a customer requests a 2-3 year quote, does Gliffy offer discounts for multi-year deals?

Yes! We love it when customers make multi-year purchases, and we will discuss discounts for each customer and each deal. Please let us know ASAP when your customer is considering a multi-year deal.

How available is a demo from someone at Gliffy? Does the customer need to meet a certain user or price level in order to get a free demo?

We love giving demos! We don't have a certain user or price level requirement for giving demos. Please reach out to us to get the demo set up. You can either join us on the demo or leave it to us to discuss with your customer via a Zoom meeting.

Is Gliffy available for extended trials past the 30 days that Atlassian typically allows for an evaluation?

Yes, we are available for extended trials. We are able to give approval for Atlassian to issue an extended trial for the license.
