Duvet Cover Specifications

- Reversible with decorative fabric on both sides
- Fabric pattern will be matched at the seams, on both front and back of the duvet cover
- Ties located inside all four corners for easy attachment to down inserts
- All duvet cover styles (except the Solid Railroaded style) feature a fabric covered button closure on top; Solid Railroaded style duvet cover features a fabric covered button closure on either the face or the top (designer's choice)

Duvet Cover Fabric Selection

- Fabrics with a vertical repeat of 36" or larger are not suitable for use in duvet covers.
- Fabrics with a horizontal repeat of 30" or larger are also not suitable for use in duvet covers.
- For face, coordinate, and back fabrics of the duvet cover, fabric width must be at least 39".
- For silk and lighter-weight fabrics, lining may be required. Consult your Kravet design associate for more information.

Railroaded vs. Up Bolt Fabrics

Railroaded Fabrics

Fabric pattern or grain runs across the roll horizontally, from selvage to selvage.



Up Bolt Fabrics

Fabric pattern or grain runs up the roll vertically, parallel to the selvages.





How to Measure a Mattress for a Duvet Cover

This guide will help you measure your mattress to determine which duvet cover size to order. To measure a mattress accurately, use a fabric measuring tape and follow the instructions below:

1. Start with a bare mattress

2. Determine mattress width

Using the tape, measure from the left side to the right side of the mattress to determine mattress width.

3. Determine mattress height

Next, measure the mattress thickness from the top of the mattress to the bottom of the mattress. This is the mattress height.



4. Determine duvet cover width

Multiply the mattress height by two and add that number to the mattress width. This amount will determine the width of duvet cover that you need to fit your mattress. For instance, if your mattress width total is 108", you will need a Super King size duvet cover. Always round up to the next size.

5. Select duvet cover size

Please refer to the chart below to select the appropriate duvet cover size for your bed.

* Super sizes are designed for pillowtop or particularly thick mattresses.

Solid Up Bolt Duvet Cover

- Fabric must be at least 39" wide
- Face fabric must be up bolt or solid
- Back fabric may be up bolt, railroaded, or solid

B. Add Small Welt

You may add a small welt (.25") to the three outer edges of the duvet cover for a decorative accent.



C. Add Medium Welt

For a decorative touch, add a medium welt (.5") to the three outer edges of the duvet cover.



D. Add 3" Flange

Give your duvet cover a clean, polished look by adding a 3" flange to the bottom and 2 outer edges of the duvet cover.



Face Finish Options



E. Add Trimming to Face

Give your duvet cover a polished look by adding a decorative trimming (with or without lip) of your choice to the face. Placement options for the trimming may vary depending on duvet cover style. Choose from gimp, braid, scallop/fan trimming, and tape.



F. Add Cuff

For a subtle accent, consider adding a cuff to the face of your duvet cover. Placement options for the cuff may vary depending on duvet cover style. K kravetbedding

Solid Railroaded Duvet Cover



Standard Features

- Interior ties for easy attachment to down inserts
- Top or face button closure—designer's choice
- (fabric covered buttons)

Fabric Requirements

- Fabric must be at least 54" wide
- Face fabric must be railroaded or solid
- Back fabric may be up bolt, railroaded, or solid

Edge Finish Options

A. Add Trimming to Edge

This option involves adding a decorative trimming (with lip) of your choice to all three outer edges of the duvet cover. Choose from bullion/fringe, cut fringe, cord with lip, loop fringe, moss/brush fringe, ruching, skirt fringe, and tassel fringe.

C. Add Medium Welt

- Fabric must be at least 39" wide
- Face fabric must be up bolt or solid
- Coordinate fabric must be up bolt or solid
 Back fabric may be up bolt, railroaded, or solid

Edge Finish Options



This option involves adding a decorative trimming (with lip) of your choice to all three outer edges of the duvet cover. Choose from bullion/fringe, cut fringe, cord with lip, loop fringe, moss/brush fringe, ruching, skirt fringe, and tassel fringe.

B. Add Small Welt

You may add a small welt (.25") to the three outer edges of the duvet cover for a decorative accent.



C. Add Medium Welt

For a decorative touch, add a medium welt (.5") to the three outer edges of the duvet cover.

Bed Skirt Specifications

- Bed skirts have a standard 3" decking border
- Split corners with kick pleats
- Choice of drop from 5" 30"

Bed Skirt Fabric Selection

- Fabric width for bed skirts (for all styles) must be at least 39".
- Face fabric (for all styles) may be up bolt, railroaded, or solid.
- For fabrics with a vertical repeat of 36" or greater, additional yardage may be required. Consult your Kravet design associate for more information.
- Horizontal repeats of all sizes work for all bed skirt styles.
- Lining may be required for silk and lighter-weight fabrics. Consult your Kravet design associate for more information.

Railroaded vs. Up Bolt Fabrics

Railroaded Fabrics

Fabric pattern or grain runs across the roll horizontally, from selvage to selvage.



Up Bolt Fabrics

Fabric pattern or grain runs up the roll vertically, parallel to the selvages.



Up bolt fabrics require multiple seams on bed skirts. Please note that up bolt fabrics are not recommended for straight bed skirts.

How to Measure a Bed for a Bed Skirt

This guide will help you measure your box spring to determine which bed skirt size to order. To measure a box spring accurately, use a fabric measuring tape and follow the instructions below:

1. Determine box spring width

Using the tape, measure the box spring from the left edge to the right edge. This is the box spring width.

2. Determine box spring height

Next, measure the box spring from the head of the bed to the foot of the bed. This is the box spring length.

3. Determine bed skirt drop

Finally, measure from the top of the box spring to the floor. This is the bed skirt drop.

4. Select bed skirt size

Match the box spring width and length to the chart below.

A. Add 3.5" Banding Add a striking accent to your bed skirt with a 3.5" band along all three sides of the skirt.
