Friday, October 10th

Welcome to Dublin, one-time home of James Joyce, George Bernard Shaw, Samuel Beckett, and W. B. Yeats! See why in recent years Dublin has also developed as one of Europe's busiest entertainment and cultural centres.

Sunday, October 12th

Discover Dublin
Get to know the city during an interactive scavenger hunt. Explore the colourful Temple Bar neighbourhood, the city's shopping and busking centre of Grafton Street, or the expansive St. Stephen's Green public park.

Stop into one of Dublin's most iconic sites – the Guinness Storehouse! Founded in 1759, it is one of the world's largest breweries and a must-see for all visitors to Dublin. You'll see how the dark brown stout is made and, of course, taste a glass as well!

Round your evening off by seeing Dublin from a different perspective on a haunted walking tour. A local guide will spin you a yarn or two about the city's history and introduce you to some of Dublin's spooky past.

Monday, October 13th

Spend the morning at one of Ireland's most interactive museums - the EPIC Irish Emigration Museum. Learn stories of Ireland's emigrants and their influence on the world over the centuries. For those with Irish heritage, make sure to check out the Irish Family History Centre and explore your personal connection to the Emerald Isle.

Enjoy some free time to explore during your last afternoon in Dublin. You may choose to stroll through leafy Trinity College, check out the city's thriving food scene, or take a beat and enjoy a coffee at one of Dublin's vibrant cafes as you watch the world go by.

Experience Irish culture and tradition at an Irish Folklore Evening. Enjoy typical Irish food and classic dancing, while exchanging stories from your weekend with your new friends!
