Take advantage of your **personal fundraising page**

Holidays & birthday gifts

How it works: Take advantage of birthdays or upcoming holidays by encouraging friends and family to donate to your trip in lieu of gifts.



Family yard sale

🕒 5 hours leading up to the event 📺 \$0 ●●○ Medium effort

How it works: Have a sale with used or donated goods.

- Collect items a week leading up to the event.
- Publicize the event throughout your area.



Themed dinner night

🕒 2–3 weeks 📺 \$0 ●●● High effort

How it works: Host a meal to support your tour.

- Get donations from grocers for supplies or buy supplies in bulk.
- Think about entertainment to go along with your meal.
- Bonus: Ask local businesses to donate gift cards, products, and services, and hold an auction or raffle for the items. Price items to attract buyers and maximize donations for your cause.
