

WALL DECAL

What you'll need:

- Tape measure or ruler
- Pencil for marking
- Cloth or sponge for cleaning the surface
- Painters tape (optional to help position before you apply)
- Level (optional)

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Helpful Tips & Tricks:

- Application recommended for smooth surfaces.
- Decals are for one-time use.
- Go slow! Especially when making your marks, to ensure your placement is level and properly positioned.
- Take your time pressing down the design to make sure all air bubbles are pushed out.
- Every space is different. You may need to space out your design more than what is shown here as an example.
- Place how you think looks best. This is just a guide!
- Have fun! We hope you love your new decal, and enjoy your new cute and cozy space!

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The decal comes in 6 separate pieces for easier positioning. See here for a breakdown of the pieces. We suggest starting with #2 and #5, since they are stacked in the middle, to help center the design. Once you've picked out the perfect spot for your new art, follow these steps to learn how to best apply your wall decal.



How to apply a wall decal:

Step 1: After you have found the perfect placement for your decal, measure out the space to ensure the best fit.

Step 2: Clean the surface of the wall by wiping away any dirt or dust using a damp cloth or sponge. Make sure you clean the wall thoroughly - if there is dirt or oil left behind on the wall, the sticker will adhere to that instead of the wall itself. The wall must be dry before you begin to apply the decal, or it will not stick properly.

Step 3: Decals can be difficult to reapply once you've used them, so make sure you have your position right on the first try. We suggest to tape the decal in the desired position, so you can take a step back and examine the placement before you apply. Using a level and a pencil, you can draw a light line to help you position the decal.

Step 4: Once you have finished adjusting the decal's position, mark its placement with your pencil. Once you have made all of your marks, you can un-tape it from the wall and get ready to apply.

Step 5: Remove the white back of the decal so the sticky side is exposed. Place the decal in the desired location with the sticky vinyl against the wall. If you make a mistake, slowly peel the decal off the wall and reapply.

Step 6: Once your decal is on the wall, you're going to want to eliminate any air bubbles. Start at the top of the decal and work your way down. Smooth the surface and eliminate any air bubbles with your fingers. Do not use a squeegee or a card to smooth, it can damage the decal and leave the art scratched or torn.

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Removal and Care:

To remove, use your fingernails to pry away a corner of the decal and peel away slowly at a 45° angle. To clean, wipe with a damp cloth.
